Preschool - K4 (4 Year Olds)

Bible: (Purposeful Design) Over the course of the year we will be discussing many Bible Truths that emphasize God's love. We cover areas such as prayer, creation, sin, forgiveness, God's promises, obedience to God, and the life of Jesus. Students, school wide, will be given weekly memory verses that focus on Godly character traits. We also have a weekly chapel with worship and a message.

Math: (BJU Press) In our math curriculum we learn to count and recognize numbers 1-20. We also introduce addition, subtraction, telling time, measuring and identifying money. We use a variety of hands-on activities in our math lessons.

Phonics and Reading (BJU Press) Our phonics program not only teaches the students letters and sounds but also aids in the development of the fine motor skills needed to learn letter formation. We love to incorporate fun activities and high level thinking to help facilitate these lessons. Towards the end of the program, word families are introduced to encourage reading in class to prepare for Kindergarten.

Social Studies and Science: (BJU Press) In the Social Studies and Science portion of the K4 program, students will learn about the life cycle of plants, animals, seasons, weather, books, U.S. presidents, the mailing system and community helpers. We encourage hands-on exploration and activities in order to engage the students and teach these concepts.

School and Music Programs: Performing in front of family and friends provides opportunities to showcase the student's talents and gifts. We have both a Christmas Program and End of the Year Program.

Activities: Our students will experience a variety of fun and educational activities that promote further learning of concepts explored in the curriculum. This may include in class experiences or field trips.
